Includes representation from provincial and federal departments (e.g. Education, Solicitor General, FNIH, etc), health services, harm reduction, community representation including multicultural, aboriginal and persons living with HIV/AIDS.

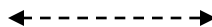
Community Planning Committees (CPC)

Community-based AIDS Organizations, local partners, Regional Health Authorities. One committee in each health authority across province. They provide feedback with local context to enhance ACHF funding proposals and inform the Consortium's decision making process.



ACHF Steward

Accountable to ACCH, AHW & PHAC through workplan and deliverables. The ACHF Steward monitors third party agreements with operational sites.



Funded Groups (ACCH membership)

Report back to ACHF Steward/ACCH who in turn are accountable to both AHW & PHAC.
